Species seed:

Matucana or Cupani	(Dark blue/purple)
L. Gelinensis	(yellow and orange)
L. Sativus	(blue)
L. Tingitanus Roseus	(pink)
L. Grandiflorus	(deep pink) - perennial
L. Chloranthus 'Lemonade'	(yellow)
